## Newman @ RIT is getting a reputation.

I was off campus on Thursday and I looked at my phone...hmmm, Jack Balinsky, the Executive Director of Catholic Charities for the Diocese of Rochester. Although I was at a location without great cell service, I took the call. Jack has heard about the good things Newman @ RIT has been doing in the areas of service and outreach as well as retreats. He then went on to tell me about a project in Sodus, NY, wondering if we would be able to help out.

La Casa is an organization through Catholic Charities of Wayne County that offers transitional housing for farm workers and their families. A farmworker and their family might stay in LaCasa for 60-90 days if grower provided housing is not available or when health issues prevent a laborer from returning to work.

The home LaCasa is using is in need of desperate repairs and cleaning out. On Saturday, November 12, from 9 am—2 pm, Jack is asking for people with muscles to help clean out this house and deposit the contents into a dumpster which will be located on the property. They will feed all the volunteers. I can promise you will work hard, never see the end results of your labors and go to bed knowing you made the lives of others better through your efforts.
