While I was there, I taught at the tribal owned preschool, assisted with the youth ministry program at the Mission Church and spent a lot of time in Glacier National Park!

Thirty years have passed since living in Montana. This summer I will be going to the wedding of one of my preschool students! I have remained close to many from St. Ignatius and I often can be heard saying, "my time in Montana made me the person I am today."

This weekend at both of the Masses, representatives from three year long volunteer organizations will be available to share information about their programs. The LaSallian Volunteers, Franciscan Volunteer Ministry and a local program - Sisters of St. Joseph Volunteer Corps. In addition, all are welcome to come to a free lunch on Monday, February 13th in the Skalny Room to talk with the representatives from each of the volunteer programs.

You might remember Cella Mahoney, who graduated last year from RIT and Sam Abraham, who graduated from RIT in 2014. They both spent a year in the Franciscan Volunteer Ministry - Cella is currently serving in Silver Springs, MD and Silver Spring is also where Sam spent her volunteer year.
