Best Lent Ever.

It is hard to believe, but Lent is less than two weeks away. Wednesday, March 1 is Ask Wednesday. Some might begin to think about what you want to do or don't want to do for Lent this year.

I recently opened a mailing that caught my attention the minute I opened it.

Don't' give up chocolate for Lent.
Do something Life Changing.

I will admit, it has me thinking. Traditionally, during the season of Lent, we attempt to give attention to fasting, prayer and giving alms. (Almsgiving-the practice of giving money or food to the poor). And so, while the beginning of Lent is still more than a week away, what might each of us do to have the best Lent ever? What might help us to "change our hearts" as we hear in the often sung Lenten song?

There are some great opportunities to consider during Lent:

- Greb Boyle, SJ is a Jesuit priest, author, speaker and expert in gang intervention. He is the founder of Homeboy Industries in Los Angeles. From 1985-1992, Fr. Boyle served as pastor of Dolores Mission Church then the poorest Catholic parish in the city, located between two large public housing projects and the territories of numerous gangs. There he and parish and community members started what would eventually become Homeboy Industries, now the largest, most successful gang intervention, rehabilitation, and re-entry program in the world. Homeboy trains and employs former gang members in a range of social enterprises, as well as provides critical services to more than 10,000 people who walk through its doors every year seeking a better life. He will be speaking at Nazareth College on Thursday, March 2 in Callahan Theater in the Arts Center at 7 pm.
